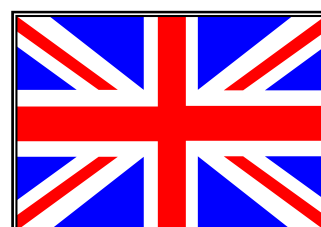
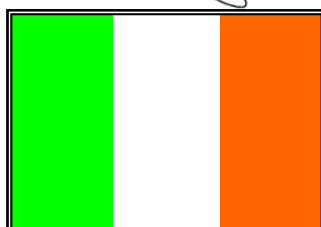
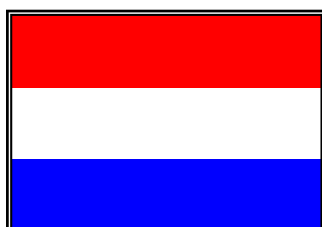
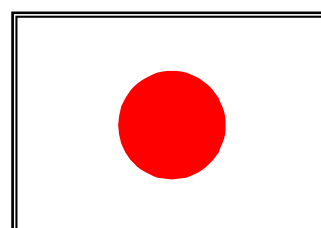
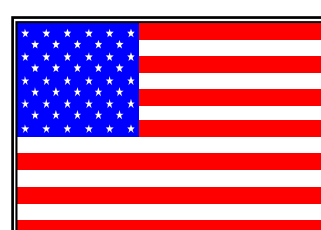
No matter where you go in the world, may the magic and spirit of Blair Atholl remain forever in your hearts.
