SATELLITE CAMP INFORMATION

Friday 20th to Monday 23rd July 2012

The 2012 event is the 33rd Jamborette. The Jamborette offers a splendid opportunity for Scottish Scouts to camp with Scouts from many different countries and to participate in a unique international event.

The purpose of the Satellite Camp at Blair Atholl is to enable Scottish "Scouts" to get a short taste of International Scouting at the Jamborette. The Satellite Camp programme is **aimed primarily at members of the Scout Section** and Patrols or Troops are welcome. Explorer Scout Units are also welcome. We regret that Beavers or Cub Scouts cannot be accepted as participants. Younger children of Leaders attending may be brought at the discretion of the Satellite Sub Camp team. Please advise on application.

There are a number of changes being made to the application process for this event in 2012 so it is very important that you read the notes that follow.

DATES

The satellite camp runs from noon on Friday 20th July to noon on Monday 23rd July 2012. This includes the middle weekend of the Jamborette including Visitors' Day and the Scouts' Own.

COST

The cost of attending is £25 per person.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO PAYMENT SHOULD BE SENT WITH THIS APPLICATION.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The Satellite Camp has, for many years, been oversubscribed and a number of applicants have been disappointed about not being able to attend. To this end a number of changes have been made to the application process.

- The application process will open on **Tuesday 17th January 2012** and will remain open for a period of **one month**.
- Once you have completed your form, have it signed by your District Commissioner and your District Explorer Scout Commissioner (If Explorer Scouts attending) and then return it to SHQ as soon as possible and certainly before the closing date of **Tuesday 14th February 2012**.
- Applications received after **Tuesday 14th February 2012** will not be accepted. This ensures that Scouts from all over the country have an **equal opportunity** to attend this camp and gives leaders sufficient time to obtain the appropriate signatures.

- After the closing date all applications will enter a ballot and places will be allocated on this basis. All applicants, successful and unsuccessful, will be notified in writing by the end of February 2012. Please note that there should be an appropriate, not excessive, ratio of adults to young people on application forms.

As no deposit is required with the form it should not be collected from the young people at this stage and it is absolutely crucial that you **do not inform Scouts they are going to Satellite Camp until you have had written confirmation from SHQ that you have been allocated places.**

FACILITIES

Toilet facilities and water points are provided. Campers must be self-sufficient in tentage, catering (with the exception of Sunday evening meal), First Aid etc.

Please note that space is not available for caravans, camper wagons etc. (Reservations with Blair Atholl Caravan Site can be made separately.)

PROGRAMME

There is a programme of activities on offer designed to assist campers to integrate and enjoy the international atmosphere of the Jamborette. These include integration and orientation activities on the Friday. On the Saturday there will be activities on the morning, an opportunity to participate in the Country Fair during the afternoon and the Jamborette campfire in the evening. The Sunday programme will include a Scouts' Own, international games and an evening BBQ in the sub-camps on the Jamborette site.

LEADERS

During the satellite camp Leaders are expected to assist with the various planned activities.

It should be noted that all adult applicants must have a current Protection of Vulnerable Groups Certificate (or Disclosure Scotland Certificate) secured through Scouting and these will be checked prior to the event by Scottish Headquarters. Any adult without this will not be allowed to attend the Satellite camp. Full details on obtaining this certificate can be provided by your Scouting Line Manager.
