CAMPING ARRANGEMENTS

The camp will have six sub-camps, each made up of twelve Patrols.

Each Patrol will have twelve members, six from a single District / Region of Scotland and six visiting Scouts from the same contingent.

Each sub-camp will have a Chief, or "Uncle", and seven or eight other staff members, including some visiting leaders. Please note that if you want to help with a sub-camp you will be asked to join one which does not have any of your Scouts.

EQUIPMENT

Your Scouts should bring only personal kit with them as the Scottish Scouts will provide all tents and cooking equipment necessary. Nearer the time of the camp a list of suggested personal and other equipment will be sent to you.

FOOD

All food during the camp is included in the camp fee. Scouts will cook in their sub-camp Patrols and all cooking will be done on wood fires.

LEADERS

Visiting leaders will be members of the camp staff and will be expected to participate fully in the camp, working hard and also enjoying the fun.

A staff form should be completed for each of your leaders - please provide as much information as possible so that appropriate jobs can be allocated - please attach a recent photograph to these forms.

Leaders will stay in the staff camp in tents provided by the Scottish leaders. All meals will be provided in the staff mess, and a staff club is provided for relaxation.

AGES

All Scouts must be aged 13, 14, 15, 16 or 17 as at 16th July 2012 and under 18 years of age on the 27th July 2012. This age range must be strictly adhered to.

COSTS

The cost of the camp is UK£240 for both Scouts and Leaders. This includes all food, services and activities at the Jamborette and travel to and from home hospitality. The fee is payable in instalments as follows. To guarantee places for your Scouts at the camp, this schedule must be met.

We will arrange overnight accommodation in Scout halls on Monday 16th July and transport to Blair Atholl on Tuesday 17th July, the cost of which is included in the camp fee.

STAFF FORMS:

Each leader in your group should complete a form as fully as possible, so that we can give them an appropriate job.

To assist us in the allocation of staff it would be helpful if these forms could be returned by 31st January 2012.
