I will try to chat with you all at some point over the next 10 days but don't wait for me to find you, feel free to come and talk to me anytime.

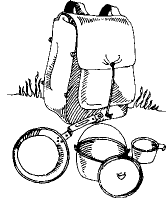

## Scottish Scouts Land On Target



429 Scottish Scouts have been arriving today in Target Field, Blair Atholl for the 33rd International Patrol Camp 2012. The Scouts have come from 29 Scottish districts to camp, eat, sleep and build friendships with 409 international Scouts. The districts are: Aberdeen, Arbroath, Borders, Buchan, Clackmannanshire, Clyde, Craigalmond, Deeside, Deveron, Dumfriesshire, Dundee, Dunfermline, East Lothian, Falkirk, Galloway, Glenrothes & Levenmout, Gordon, Greenock & District, Kincardineshire, Moray, North East Fife, Paisley & District, Perth & Kinross, Renfrewshire, Rosyth, Stirling & Trossachs, South Angus, Western Isles and West Lothian.

The Scouts were greeted by a welcoming registration staff and then taken off to their subcamps where they were introduced to their new home for the next 12 nights.

Welcome to Blair Atholl from the camp medical team. Dr Colin, Dr Marion and a group of enthusiastic first aiders, paramedics, nurses and more are hoping you have a fantastic time and never have the misfortune of needing our medical attention.

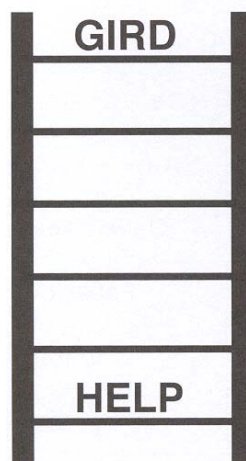
Because you'll be camping here for 11 nights it's especially important that you try to keep yourself healthy so here's some helpful advice:

- If there's sun – wear hats, t-shirts and suntan lotion...If it's raining – keep dry.
- If you're dirty – wash.....If you're not dirty – wash anyway (including your feet).
- If you're cooking or eating – wash your hands before you do so.
- If you're injured.... see subcamp staff first (you can apply your own plaster if you want).
- If you're more seriously injured or unwell.... see subcamp staff who can arrange for you to see the doctor.
- If you have an upset stomach or tick bites, tell the subcamp staff.
- If you're accident prone, wear protective clothing at all times .... if you're not accident prone, take care anyway, especially around guy ropes, fires and sharp objects!!
- If wee is clear, no problem here, if wee is yellow, ill fellow.... drink plenty.

Most importantly have fun, enjoy the camp and if you need the medical team, we're here to help.
